A male suspect is being sought in connection with a car burglary that occurred two weeks ago at an A1A South parking lot (Ft. Matanzas beach access). The 65-year old male victim stated that he and his wife parked their vehicle on 02 January at 12:30 p.m. and walked on the beach. He returned thirty minutes later and received a cell phone call from an unknown woman who stated that she found some personal property belonging to the victim in the parking lot of her condo.

Later that afternoon the victim discovered that his wallet was missing from a storage compartment inside the vehicle. He also discovered that two of his credit cards had been used at several locations in St. Johns and Clay Counties and determined that the wallet was taken in a burglary at the beach.
