Detectives with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office Special Victims' Unit along with Deputies are continuing to seek a male suspect wanted in connection with an attack on a female jogger early Sunday evening.

Just before dusk on Sunday, a female was jogging near Old Moultrie Road just north of Lewis Point Road. A male suspect approached and attacked her from behind, taking her to the ground. The victim struggled with the suspect until she was able to break free and run for assistance.

The suspect, seen in the attached composite, is described as a white male in his early to mid 40's, possibly between 5'10" and 6'02" tall, 180-220 lbs with brown hair and a full beard.

The hair may have been shoulder length. He was last seen wearing dark pants and a white t-shirt with some sort of design on it.
