Two male suspects are being sought in connection with two residential burglaries that occurred Sunday in the Northwest part of the county. The first occurred at a residence in the 6400 block of Jack Wright Island Rd. early Sunday afternoon. Entry was gained by smashing a rear door. The home was ransacked and personal property was scattered, however nothing was noted missing.

The second burglary occurred later in the afternoon at a residence in the 1900 block of Village Glen Dr. Entry was also gained by smashing the rear door. Reported stolen was currency and assorted jewelry.

Through witness accounts, Property Crimes Unit Detectives discovered an older model, two-door, Red Honda DELSOL was seen parked on the road side near the two homes that had been burglarized. The vehicle had extensive front end damage to include bungie cords holding the hood. The vehicle was also occupied by two young white males, possibly in their 20's. One had blonde hair and the other had dark hair and a thin build.
