**6 January 2012**

Traffic Homicide Investigators from the St Johns County Sheriff's Office are continuing to investigate an early morning hit and run crash with life threatening injuries. Deputies responded to the area of Old Moultrie Rd and Hastings Rd. today at 5:40 a.m. in reference to a male subject that had been struck while riding a moped.

The victim (*Nathaniel Callahan*, 30, St. Augustine) was driving his moped southbound on Old Moultrie Rd. when he was rear ended by a vehicle. The victim was transported to Flagler Hospital by Fire/Rescue Personnel with life threatening injuries. Surveillance video captured a grainy image of the suspect vehicle that appeared to be a dark colored van. Traffic Homicide Investigators have been able to identify the suspect vehicle as a 1999-2003 dark colored Ford Windstar minivan. That identification was made by identifying parts of the vehicle that were found at the scene to include the front headlight/fog light. The vehicle should have damage to the passenger front turn signal and headlight area.
