# S.T.O.P.P.E.D.

Sheriffs Telling Our Parents & Promoting Educated Drivers



Sheriff David B. Shoar is pleased to introduce the S.T.O.P.P.E.D. program. A parental notification system developed to help reduce the number of young drivers involved in motor vehicle accidents.

Annually over 3,000 drivers between sixteen and twenty-one years of age die in the United States as a result of car crashes.

In St. Johns County, young drivers represent 3% of all drivers in fatal crashes and 23% of all drivers involved in personal injury automobile accidents.

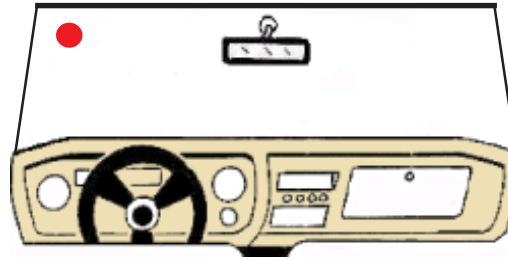
The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office offers parents this voluntary notification system to extend their watchful eyes and raise the awareness of drivers under age of 21.

## On Your Mark

Parents voluntarily register with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office any motor vehicle that will be operated by a driver under the age of 21.

## Get Set

An identification decal is issued and affixed to the windshield of each registered vehicle.



## S.T.O.P.P.E.D.

If for any reason the registered vehicle, when operated by a driver under the age of 21, is stopped by Sheriff's Deputies, the deputy will complete a notification card providing the following information:

- Time and location of stop
- Driver's name and the number of passengers
- Reason for the stop
- Whether any traffic tickets were issued.

Notifications will be mailed directly to parents to make them aware of potential problems and enable them to coexist with teenage driving privileges.
