

The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office would like to give notice of our application for the Fiscal Year 2017 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. As part of the \$5,994,513 funding issued to the state of Florida, St. Johns County will receive \$28,312.00. Grant funds must be used in accordance with the guidelines below per the U.S. Department of Justice:

JAG funds may be used for state and local initiatives, technical assistance, strategic planning, research and evaluation (including forensics), data collection, training, personnel, equipment, forensic laboratories, supplies, contractual support, and criminal justice information systems that will improve or enhance such areas as:

- Law enforcement programs.
- Prosecution and court programs, including indigent defense.
- Prevention and education programs.
- Corrections and community corrections programs.
- Drug treatment and enforcement programs.
- Planning, evaluation, and technology improvement programs.
- Crime victim and witness programs (other than compensation)
