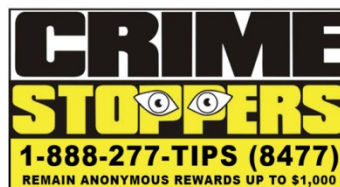
The St. Johns County Sheriff's Office would like to alert residents of the Ponte Vedra Beach area and those traveling to Ponte Vedra Beach on Sunday, 11 February 2018 to expect traffic congestion and delays.

The National Marathon to Finish Breast Cancer will be held on Sunday, February 11, 2018. The race will begin at 7:30 a.m. The most delays are expected to be between 7:15-9:00 a.m. A1A will be closed between C.R. 210 and Corona Rd. during this time.

Traffic will be diverted to Roscoe Blvd. enabling most motorists to bypass the event. Commuters can also expect congestion and traffic delays following the event as shuttles will be traveling southbound on A1A returning participants to the TPC parking lot.
