ST. JOHNS COUNTY INMATE HAS THREE CAPITAL FELONY CHARGES ADDED

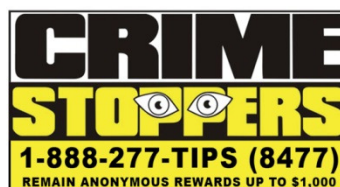

Three additional charges of capital sexual battery were signed on a 53-year old St. Johns County man who is currently serving time in the St. Johns County Jail on a charge of unlawful sexual activity with a minor. Special Victims Unit (SVU) detectives charged the suspect, identified as **Daniel Gerald Delany**, 53, lka of 7215 Old S.R. 207, after the victim disclosed the alleged allegations of sexual abuse to a counselor.

The SVU investigation revealed that the suspect had allegedly committed sexual battery on the victim on at least three occasions when the victim was less than 12 years of age. Detectives then questioned the suspect and arrested him at the jail for the three capital felony charges. Bond was set at \$1.5 million at his first appearance hearing the following day.

Delany was arrested earlier this year for interference with custody after an investigation by SVU detectives revealed he picked up teenage runaway in the Orlando area. That investigation led to the additional charge and conviction of unlawful sexual activity with a minor. He was sentenced to 364 days in the County Jail followed by five years of sex offender probation and is currently serving that sentence.
