DUVAL COUNTY MAN ARRESTED ON THREE FELONY CHARGES

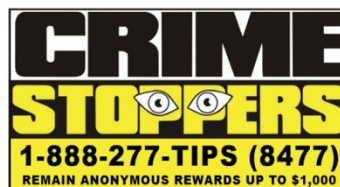

A 24-year old Duval County man was arrested on several charges after he began communicating with an undercover detective whom he thought was a child earlier this month. The suspect, identified as **Kameron Brennen Ruhe**, 24, 3601 S. Kernan Blvd Apt. 922, Jacksonville, was charged with use of computer to seduce, solicit, lure or entice a child or person believed to be a child to commit an unlawful sexual act with a child, transmit harmful materials to a minor, and unlawful use of a two-way communication device.

Cyber Crimes Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Detectives with the Sheriff's Office Special Victims' Unit began the investigation earlier this month to target individuals that use the Internet to sexually exploit children. The suspect responded to the undercover detective who he believed to be a child and began a conversation. In addition to the suspect allegedly seeking to meet the child, he allegedly sent the detective a photo of himself exposing himself.

Detectives obtained an arrest warrant Wednesday and Jacksonville Sheriff's Officers located the suspect today and arrested him on the St. Johns County Warrant that carries a \$60,000 bond. He was booked into the Duval County Jail.
