38-YEAR OLD MAN ARRESTED ON A FUGITIVE WARRANT

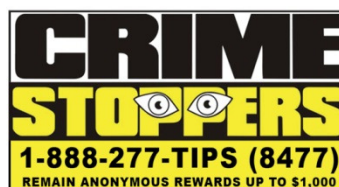
A 38-year old St. Johns County man, who fled on foot from a traffic stop Wednesday, was taken into custody without incident early this (Friday) morning. Following a brief standoff, the suspect, identified as **Michael Edward Green**, 38, no address, was taken into custody at a residence in the 1800 block of Neal Rd. He is charged with a federal VOP warrant out of Virginia for manufacturing methamphetamine and was turned over to the U.S. Marshal's Service.

Green was a passenger in a pickup truck early Wednesday morning when deputies observed the vehicle at a construction site on Dobbs Cutoff Rd. The driver sped away but stopped for a traffic stop near the intersection of S.R. 312 & S.R. 207 a short time later. Green bailed from the passenger side and fled into the woods on foot. A Sheriff's Office K-9 team along with Air One responded, however, Green eluded capture.

Deputies learned that Green was hiding in a residence in the 1800 block of Neal Rd. early this (Friday) morning. Deputies surrounded the residence at 1:30 a.m. After several commands through a PA system requesting Green to exit the residence, he surrendered without further incident and was secured.

Additional charges are pending further investigation.
