PERSON OF INTEREST SOUGHT IN RECENT BUSINESS BURGLARIES

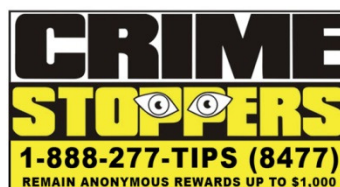
District Detectives with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office are seeking the identity of an individual as a Person of Interest in connection with two business burglaries last month in the 2800 block of C.R. 210 West.

Shortly after 4:00 a.m., on 04 April, at least five vehicles arrived at the Publix Shopping Plaza and park in front of the two businesses that were entered that morning; the Verizon store and Rivertown Fine Wine & Spirits. At least eight male subjects enter the Verizon store through the smashed front door glass. A cell phone along with two I-Pads was stolen from the store. The suspects also smashed the front door to the adjacent liquor store. Numerous bottles of liquor and cash were taken from that business.

The Person of Interest in connection with these burglaries entered the liquor store the previous evening and purchased two small bottles of alcohol. The subject appeared to be intently looking around the area and was wearing a dark colored shirt and what appears to be acid washed jeans. The first male who entered the store during the burglary appeared to be wearing the same jeans.
