SEXUAL PREDATOR NOTIFICATION

In accordance with Florida State Statute 775.21, this news release will serve as public notification that the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office has been given information that a person judged to be a sexual predator has moved into St. Johns County.

The name of the sexual predator is Brantley Vernon Bennett. He will be residing at 483 Pomont Ave., St. Augustine 32084. Bennett is a white male, 33-years of age, 5'07" tall, 150 pounds with blonde hair and blue eyes.

Bennett was sentenced to three years in prison in 2012 on two counts of sexual battery upon a victim under 12 years of age when he was under 18. He was released from prison on 01 October 2017 in Polk County and moved to St. Johns County today, 08 January 2018. Bennett is classified as a Sexual Predator.
